II. FORWARD BY THE CEC

Pursuant to Section 166 of the Public Finance Management Act, an Accounting Officer for a County Government entity shall prepare Financial Report for each quarter of the financial year in respect of the entity in formats prescribed by the Accounting Standards Board. The law requires that these statements are submitted to the Auditor General, the National Treasury, the Controller of Budget and Commission for Revenue Allocation within one month after the end of each Financial Quarter. The attached Financial Statements which have been prepared in line with the requirements of the (PFMA),2012, present a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the County Government of Makueni for the nine months period ending March 31, 2018.

During the period ended 31st March 2018, the County Government of Makueni received Kshs. 118.6 million for Road Maintenance Fuel Levy, Kshs. 141.3 million from foreign grants Kshs. 3.45 billion as exchequer revenue. The Countys' own generated revenue was Kshs. 207.2 million. The County has a recurrent expenditure of Kshs.3.92 billion, transfers to County Assembly of Kshs. 375.6 million and Kshs. 441.7 million expenditure in development. Part of our expenditure has been footed by the reallocation budget of Kshs.1.23 billion.

In order to ensure improved transparency, accountability and fiscal responsibility in the public sector, the County Government of Makueni is committed to prudent management of finances guided by sound financial policies and guidelines that ensure efficient utilization of resources. The County Budget and Economic forum has played a key role in supporting a sound budget process. We have also continuously updated Makueni citizens on matters of public finance through various media. The County Government is also dedicated to deliver on the promises made in her budget. This will help bolster the key objective of devolution which is to promote sustainable and equitable social, political and economic development in the County.

The main challenge faced during the quarter was delayed release of funds from the exchequer hence little or no procurement of goods and services in the County.

As I conclude, I would like to thank the National Treasury for the support they gave during the financial year.

III. STATEMENT OF MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES

Sections 166 the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 requires that, the County Treasury shall prepare report for each quarter of the financial year in respect of the entity in accordance with the standards and formats prescribed by the Public Sector Accounting Standards Board.

The County Executive Committee (CEC) member for finance of the County Government is responsible for the preparation and presentation of the County Government's financial statements, which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the County Government for and as at the end of the period ended March 31, 2018. This responsibility includes: (i) maintaining adequate financial management arrangements and ensuring that these continue to be effective throughout the reporting period; (ii) maintaining proper accounting records, which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the County Government; (iii) designing, implementing and maintaining internal controls relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements, and ensuring that they are free from material misstatements, whether due to error or fraud; (iv) safeguarding the assets of the County Government; (v) selecting and applying appropriate accounting policies; and (vi) making accounting estimates that are reasonable in the circumstances.

The CEC member for finance accepts responsibility for the County Government's financial statements, which have been prepared on the Cash Basis Method of Financial Reporting, using appropriate accounting policies in accordance with International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS). The CEC member for finance is of the opinion that the County Government's financial statements give a true and fair view of the state of the County Government's transactions during the period ended March 31, 2018, and of its financial position as at that date. The CEC member for finance further confirms the completeness of the accounting records maintained for the County Government which have been relied upon in the preparation of the its financial statements as well as the adequacy of the systems of internal financial control.

The CEC member for finance confirms that the County Government has complied fully with applicable Government Regulations and the terms of external financing covenants (where applicable), and that the County Government's funds received during the year under audit were used for the eligible purposes for which they were intended and were properly accounted for. Further the CEC member for finance confirms that the County Government's financial statements have been prepared in a form that complies with relevant accounting standards prescribed by the Public Sector Accounting Standards Board of Kenya.
