EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1 OF 2020 – THE ORGANIZATION OF GOVERNMENT

The Executive Order codifies various changes made to the structure of Government over the last two years; including but not limited to the re-alignment of Ministerial Portfolios, Mandate changes, State Appointments, and the re-assignments and vacation of the appointment of State Officers serving in the Senior Ranks of the Executive and the National Security Organs.

Accordingly, and by the way of this Circular, you are notified that the Executive Order No. 1 of 2020 supersedes Executive Order No. 1 of 2018 (Revised), which was issued in July 2018. By a copy of this Circular, **The National Treasury** is requested to take note of any changes in Ministerial Portfolio and Mandate, and to further align the ministerial budgets in accordance to **Executive Order No. 1 of 2020**.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1 OF 2020

THE ORGANIZATION OF GOVERNMENT

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by Article 132 (3) (b) of the Constitution, as read with all other enabling Laws, I, **UHURU KENYATTA**, President and Commander-in-Chief of the Kenya Defence Forces, order and direct:

- (i) **THAT** the Government shall be organized as set out in this Order;
- (ii) **THAT** this Order contains portfolio responsibilities and changes made in the structure of Government;
- (iii) **THAT** this Order assigns functions and institutions among Ministries and State Departments; and
- (iv) **THAT** this Order supersedes Executive Order No. **1** of 2018 (Revised) issued in July **2018**.
